

Gen V Arm - Cutting the Slot



If you use an arm that was used for a fixed residential installation, it will likely not have the usual slot on the end of the arm. The slot makes setup quite a bit easier.

By cutting this piece of metal out of the arm end, it enables you to slide the arm into its proper location on the dish, without completely removing the knob or other hardware that holds the arm in place.

The photo above shows a HughesNet Gen V feed arm, after the slot has been cut out.
