Today we head to Phoenix for the HughesNet Installer Hands-on class tomorrow. Once that is complete, we will finally have installer certification and can get our dealer system online!

The next step is to pull together some documentation for the rest of you to do the same. Likely the early installations will need more telephone support, as we fine-tune our documentation, but that is included in the "New Setup" service package we offer.

We have the first 4 installations scheduled for October and this should provide even more information for putting together good documentation.

Here is a little more information about how we plan to eventually get all of you who want to travel with Ka-band HughesNet installer certified - Please share the following information **very selectively**:

While we have permission to do mobile satellite Internet all the way to the director level, not all of HughesNet corporate yet approves of mobile users. So, that means we have to hold our cards close to our chest at this stage.

In the initial phase, you will use my installer ID to verify your alignment. Not only is this an immediate solution that allows you to travel with your HughesNet system, but it will also help my installer ID total up enough "installations" to qualify sooner to attend the HughesNet "train the trainer" course. Once I pass that, I will be approved to certify HughesNet installers.

And, once I can do that, we will have an online discussion/class and you will take the exam which will be ready by then. Once you pass the exam, you will get HughesNet installer certification.

So that's the plan for installer certification!

In the interest of keeping things "under the radar" we have redone our web site. It still includes the info about cost, speeds, etc but doesn't specifically mention HughesNet Ka-band as a mobile service. HughesNet still appears on our site, but mostly as examples and/or in graphics. So, check it out and let me know if you notice any potential issues.

HughesNet has been used as a mobile service since about 2001 and I'm happy to see that it is getting closer at last, to officially "coming out"! ;-)

I'm also very happy to be a part of that, after a long history with HughesNet! :-)
